Via Dolorosa

Also known as "The Way of the Cross" or "The Way of the Sorrow," it is a tiny, stone path that is thought to have been used by Jesus on the way to His crucifixion about 2000 years ago.



Chapel of the Ascension

The Chapel of the Ascension on the Mount of Olives marks the location where Christ ascended to heaven and will return to during His second coming.
