Everything Is Close

- **Galilee** : Capernaum, Tabgha, Beatitudes in one morning.
- **Jerusalem** : Western Wall, Holy Sepulchre, Mount Zion in 30 mins.
- **Less travel, more time to reflect and pray.**

The Bible Clicks

- **Jordan River** : Baptism comes alive.
- **Jerusalem** : Stones & prayers hold centuries.
- **Nazareth** : Homes make Mary & Joseph real.
- **Verses anchor to places, not abstractions.**

Welcoming People

- **Guides** : Keep flow, explain in Bible context.
- **Drivers** : Safe routes, cool bus, water ready.
- **Locals** : “Shalom” and respect open doors.

Smart Tips

- **Comfy shoes, refillable bottle, hat + sunscreen.**
- **Notebook for prayers, quiet pause at sites.**
- **Ask guides for cultural insight.**
- **Offline Bible app for verses.**
- **Small cash, respectful clothing, power bank.**

Best Time

- **Spring** : Mild, blooms, fewer crowds.
- **Fall** : Clear, warm, ideal walks.
- **Summer** : Hot, manageable with early starts.
- **Winter** : Cool, peaceful, fewer visitors.
