Nazareth: Where Jesus Was Raised

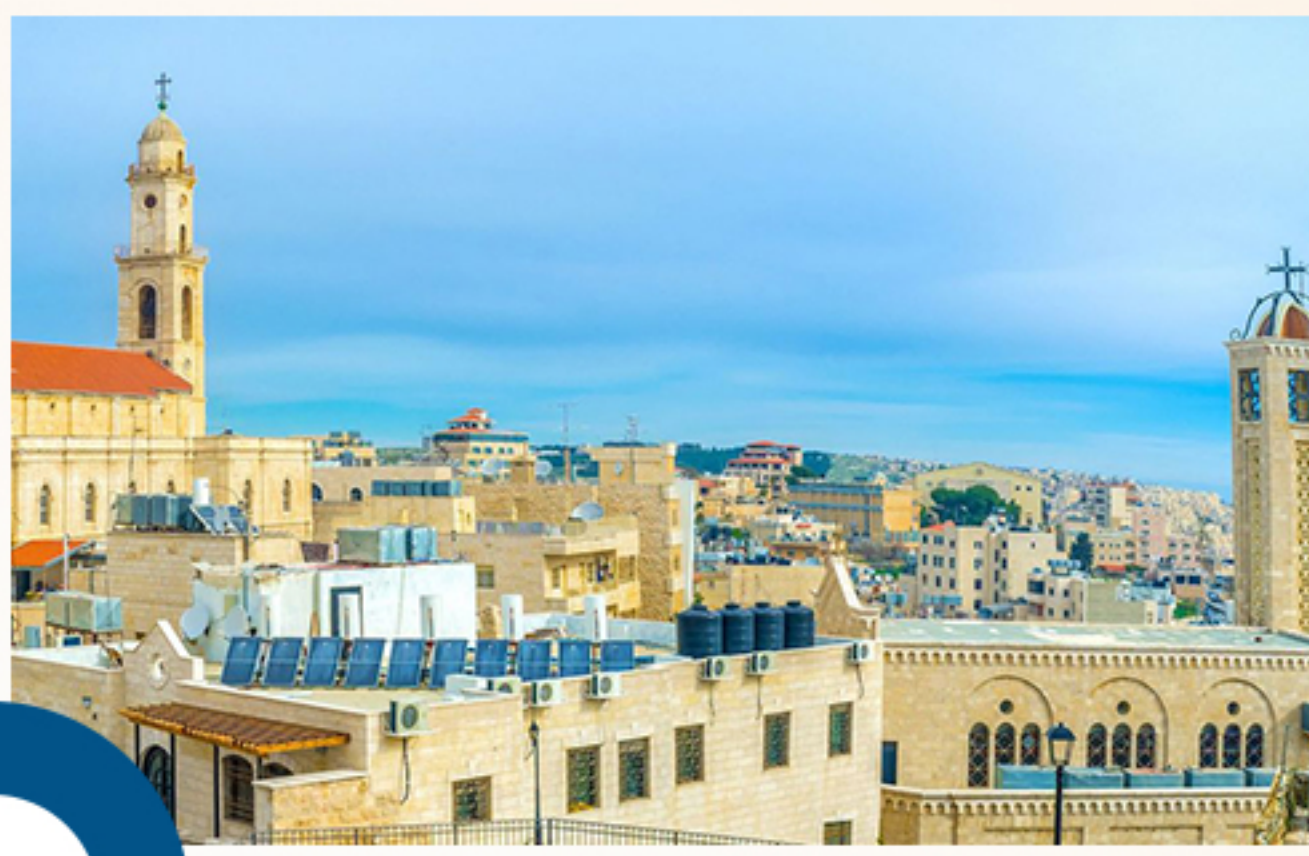
- **Basilica of the Annunciation:** Gabriel's announcement to Mary.
