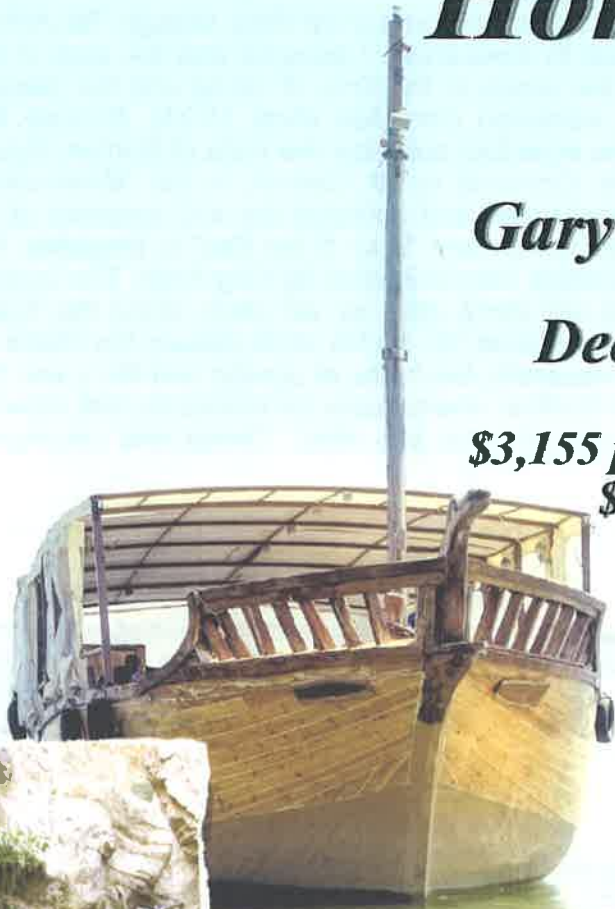

Day 1 – Monday – December 2: Departure

Depart on an overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – Tuesday – December 3: Arrival – Jaffa – Ashod

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion airport you will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel & Tours representative at the airport. Meet your guide and drive to **Jaffa**. Jaffa has been known in the bible as Joppa and is considered the world's oldest port and the place where the prophet Jonah set sail for Tarshish. Jaffa is associated with the deeds of Peter. Here Tabitha was resurrected by St. Peter (Acts 9: 35-43). Enjoy a walking tour in the old city of Jaffa. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Ashdod.

Day 3 – Wednesday – December 4: Caesarea - Mt. Carmel – Megiddo – Sea of Galilee

After our Israeli breakfast and a short drive through Tel Aviv, travel via the Sharon plain to **Caesarea**. Caesarea was the seat of the Roman Procurator of the Judea in the time of Christ and the place St. Peter converted the centurion Cornelius (Acts 10:24). Explore the Roman Theater and the aqueduct and view the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Continue to Mt. Carmel, to the "**Mukhraka**" the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (King 18:20). Drive via the ancient "Way of the Sea" to **Megiddo**, the fortress city of King Solomon, later built upon by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon (Revelation 16: 14-19) while viewing the Plains of Jezreel. Drive through **Nazareth**, the home of Joseph and Mary and through the city of **Cana of Galilee**, where Jesus performed his first miracle (John 2: 1-11): turning jars of water into wine. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 4 – Thursday – December 5: Sea of Galilee- Golan Heights

The day starts with a **boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee. At Kibbutz Ginnosar, visit the "**Ancient Boat**" believed to be from Jesus' time. Continue to **Tabgha** where the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes took place. Visit the ancient boat at Kibbutz Ginossar. Continue on to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Drive along the Hula Valley to **Tel Dan** and visit the remains of the city. For lunch you will be able to sample the St. Peter fish (on your own). Continue to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter made his confession of faith to Jesus. Via a ride through the **Golan Heights** we return to the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, the area where Jesus spent his years of ministry. See the ruins of **Capernaum**, the town where Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. View the remains of the ancient synagogue in which he may have preached and the house of Peter. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 5 – Friday – December 6: Bet She'an – Bet Alfa – Gideon Spring - Jerusalem

After breakfast you will have an opportunity to be baptized at **Yardenit**. Then, leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to **Bet She'an**. Recent excavations there have disclosed the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 CE. Visit **Ein Harod**, the site of **Judge Gideon** (Judges 7: 1-25). The tour continues through the **Jordan Valley** past **Jericho**, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt –'and the walls fell down'. It was also the site of the Mount of Temptation. (Mark 1:13). Drive to **Jerusalem**. Enter the city of Jerusalem in the traditional way and view the city from Mt. Scopus. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 6 – Saturday – December 7: Massada – Shderot

After an early breakfast depart Jerusalem and travel along the shore of the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth to **Massada**. Ascend Massada by cable car. Massada is the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish history. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp and the oldest synagogue in the world. Continue to **Shderot** and visit a children's bomb shelter to experience Israeli life. **Give bandanas with "Soldiers Prayer—Ps 91" in Hebrew and English to IDF soldiers along the way.** Return to Jerusalem passing the traditional site of the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 7 – Sunday – December 8: Jerusalem

After breakfast we'll ascend the **Mt. of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the old city of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday way**. Descend to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the **Church of All Nations**. Drive along the "**Last Way**" to **Mt. Zion**. Cross the Kidron Valley and see the Tombs of Absalom, Zachary and James. Visit the **City of David** and **Pool of Siloam**. Continue on to the **Last Supper Room** and **King David's Tomb**. End the day with a visit to the Rabbinical Tunnel. You will also visit the **Church of St. Anne** and the **Pools of Bethesda**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 8 – Monday – December 9: Jerusalem - Bethlehem

The day starts with a visit to **Mt. Moriah**. Walk through the Jewish Quarter to the **Western Wall** and experience a special communion and ceremony. Continue on to the **Southern Wall excavation** at the **Davidson Center**. In the afternoon visit **Shepherds' Field** and the **Church of Nativity** at **Bethlehem**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 9 – Tuesday – December 10: Jerusalem

This morning drive to the western side of the city and visit **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Museum. See the **Menorah** next to the Knesset building. Then, visit to the **Israel Museum** where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept in the **Shrine of the Book** and the **Holy Land model** of Jerusalem as it was in the Second Temple period (the time of Jesus). You will also visit the **House of the High Priest Caiphas** and the **Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu**. This is the Place where Peter denied his Lord 3 times. End the day at the **Garden Tomb**. **Farewell dinner.** Overnight: Hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 10 – Wednesday – December 11: Departure Israel – Arrival USA

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA. Arrive the same day.
