Day 1 – Tuesday – March 22: Flight
Nonstop flight from USA to Tel-Aviv.

Day 2 – Wednesday – March 23:
Arrival – Tel Aviv

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion airport you will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel & Tours representative at the airport. Meet your guide and drive to Tel Aviv. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tel Aviv.

Day 3 – Thursday – March 24:
Tel Beer Sheba – Susya – Har Amasa – Dead Sea

After your Israeli breakfast, depart your hotel and drive south to **Tel Beer Sheba** to visit the site. Continue on to **Susya Synagogue**. Believers in Yeshua are documented to have worshiped at this site between 200-300 CE (AD). You will be the guest of Marcelyn and Robert Brecka, at **Har Amasa**, who will show you **Patriach's Trail** and the kibbutz community they are helping to rebuild. End your day at your hotel at the **Dead Sea**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel at the Dead Sea.

Day 4 – Friday – March 25:
Massada – Ein Gedi – Qumran – Jordan Valley – Nazareth

This morning drive to **Massada**. Ascend to the fortress by cable car. Explore the excavations of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp, and the oldest synagogue in the world. Continue on to **Ein Gedi Nature Reserve**, an oasis of waterfalls on the Dead Sea shore. In this area is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul (1 Samuel 24: 1-22). Optional hike to the upper falls of David's Stream. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Stop at **Kaser Al Yahud** for a brief visit. The tour continues along the Jordan Valley. Visit **Mt. Precipice**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Nazareth.

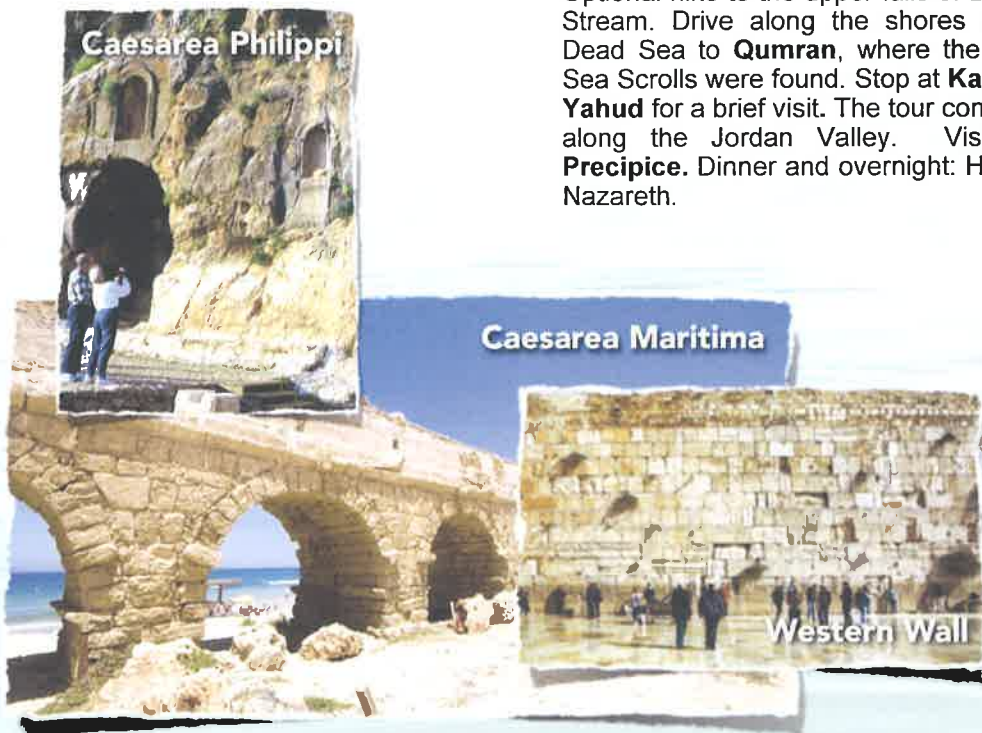
Day 5 – Saturday – March 26:
Mt. Carmel – Megiddo – Nazareth
The day starts ascending **Mt. Carmel** and visiting the **Mukhraka** where the prophet Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal and called down fire on the Altar. From here you will have an overlook of the Valley of Armageddon and the Kishon River. At **Kehilat Ha'Carmel** attend an orientation and the worship. Lunch will be at a Druze Village. Continue to **Megiddo**, the Fortress City of King Solomon. View the **Plains of Jezreel**, where the final Battle of Armageddon is spoken of in the books of Daniel and Revelation. End the day with a visit to **Nazareth Village** which depicts the Jewish rural community life of 2,000 years ago. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Nazareth.

Day 6 – Sunday – March 27:
Sepphoris – Mt. Arbel – around the Sea of Galilee

Drive to visit **Sepphoris**. Stop at **Mt. Arbel** for a panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee. Take a **boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee. At **Kibbutz Ginnosar** you will be able to see the "**ancient boat**" believed to be from Jesus' time. End the day at **Yardenit** with an opportunity to be baptized (optional). Dinner and overnight: Kibbutz near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 7 – Monday – March 28:
Around the Sea of Galilee – Golan Heights

Your first visit today will be to **Magdala**. Drive to the **Valley of the Doves**. Visit the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Continue to **Tabgha** to visit Peter's Primacy. Visit **Capernaum**, the town Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth (Matthew 4:13). Visit the excavation of the ancient synagogue and the house of St. Peter. View one of Israel's scenic wonders at **Banias Falls**. Continue to the site of



ancient **Caesarea Philippi**. It is here that Peter made his confession that Jesus is the Christ (Matthew 16:16). At the **Golan Heights** stop at **Mt. Bental**. Drive by the site of Gadarene Demoniac. Dinner and overnight: Kibbutz near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 8 – Tuesday – March 29:

Bet Saida – Katzrin - Gamla

This morning you will visit **Bet Saida**. At **Katzrin**, visit the **Capernaum Vista Olive Oil Mill** and **Kessem Hagolan**. Continue to the nature reserve of **Gamla**. Dinner and overnight: Kibbutz near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 9 – Wednesday – March 30:

Gideon Spring – Caesarea – Jaffa – Rehovot – Jerusalem

Depart the Sea of Galilee and drive to visit **Ein Harod (Gideon Spring)**, the site of Judge Gideon (Judges 7: 1-25). Continue to **Caesarea** the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea in the time of Christ. This is where Peter preached in Cornelius's house (Acts 10:24-48) and where Paul stood trial. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times, explore the aqueduct. Drive along the Sharon Plains to **Jaffa**, known in the bible as Joppa and considered to be the world's oldest port. This is the place where the prophet Jonah set sail for Tarshish. Jaffa is associated with the deeds of Peter. You will visit the Tel. Continue on to **Rehovot** and visit the **Bullet Factory** at the **Ayalon Institute**. Drive up to **Jerusalem** and enter the city as pilgrim. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 - Thursday – March 31:

Shiloh – Hebron - Jerusalem

This morning drive to **Shiloh** and visit the **Synagogue, Classroom, Therapy Center** the **Visitors Center** (that includes the film) and the **Tabernacle site**. Visit **Hebron** and the **Cave of the Patriarchs**. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Friday – April 1:
Jerusalem – Genesis Land

In the morning drive to the west side of the city. Stop at the **Menorah**, the symbol of the State of Israel near the Knesset, the Israeli Parliament. Then, visit **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust museum. Drive out of Jerusalem to **Genesis Land** where you will have Abraham hospitality, camel ride and special lunch. Drive to **Mt. Of Olives** where Jesus prayed and ascended into Heaven and will return again. View the Jewish cemetery below and the Old City across the Kidron Valley. Spend a quiet time in the **Garden of Gethsemane** (in the open garden). Visit the **Church of All Nations**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 12 – Saturday – April 2:
Jerusalem

After breakfast you will visit the **Church of Peter in Gallicantu**, the site where Peter denied his Lord three times. It was also the House of the **High Priest Caiphas** where Jesus was interrogated. Drive to **Jaffa Gate** and enter the Old City. If time permits visit the Ethiopian Monastery. See the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. Walk along the **Via Dolorosa** in the Moslem Quarter to visit **St. Anne's Church and Pools of Bethesda**. End your day with a tour and communion at the **Garden Tomb**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 13 – Sunday – April 3:
Jerusalem - Bethlehem

After breakfast, drive to **Mt Moriah**, where Abraham was willing to sacrifice his son Isaac. Continue to the **Rabbinical Tunnel**. Visit the **City of David** and see the Multi Media, the Gihon Spring, Hezekiah's Tunnel and Pool of Siloam. Then drive to **Bethlehem**; Drive by the **Church of the Nativity**. Visit **Shepherd's Fields** and the **First Baptist Church** to encourage and worship with Christian believers in Bethlehem. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 14 – Monday – April 4:
Jerusalem – Departure

Your first stop today at the Old City will be the **Davidson Center**. Visit the Southern Wall excavations including the multi-media show. Stop at the **Western Wall**. Explore the Jewish and Armenian Quarters. At the western side of the city visit the **Israel Museum**, the **Shrine of the Book** (where some of the Dead Sea Scrolls and Bar Kokhva letters are exhibited) and the **Holy Land Model**. Free time at the **Old City**. **Farewell Dinner**. Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA.

Day 15 - Tuesday – April 5:
Tel Aviv - USA

Your flight back to the USA departs around midnight. Arrive the same day.

4. riding or driving in races, or speed or endurance competitions or events;
5. mountaineering (engaging in the sport of scaling mountains generally requiring the use of picks, ropes, or other special equipment);
6. participating as a professional in a stunt, athletic or sporting event or competition;
7. participating in skydiving or parachuting except parasailing, hang gliding, bungee cord jumping, extreme skiing, skiing outside marked trails or heli-skiing, any race, speed contests, spelunking or caving, or scuba diving if the depth exceeds 120 feet (40 meters) or if You are not certified to dive and a dive master is not present during the dive;
8. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft;
9. being Intoxicated as defined in the Plan, or under the influence of any controlled substance unless as administered or prescribed by a Legally Qualified Physician;
10. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation;
11. normal childbirth or pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or voluntarily induced abortion;

20. Bankruptcy or Default or failure to supply services by a supplier of travel services; or
21. an assessment from a Legally Qualified Physician advising You in writing that You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member or Business Partner booked to travel with You are not Medically Fit to Travel, as defined in the Plan, at the time of purchase of Coverage for a Trip.
